

# Saturday Stitchers 20th May 10:30am-4pm



### Ruler / Laptop / iPad bag

The aim for making these bags is to use fabric from your stash and any scrappy leftovers you have. You could even use the leftover blocks you may have.

And if you find yourself getting confused with how much fabric you need, just bring lots of fabric and I will help you work it all out!!

### Requirements

### Ruler Bag

**Lining:** Fabric to equal finished length 56 inches  $\times$  8 inches

Wadding or Pellon: to equal finished length 56 inches x 8 inches

(these do not need to be whole piece of fabric/wadding/pellon, it can be stitched together

to create the required length)

Outer: Bring along all your scraps and left overs and we will fill the lining with a crazy patch quiltas-you-go. You will need enough fabric to cover 56 x 8 fabric length.

**Binding**: equal to  $4 \times WOF \times 2^{\frac{3}{4}}$  inches

Closer: button, Velcro, hooks, ribbon (pretty much whatever you have on hand) I will help you make it into a closer for your bag.

### Laptop/iPad Bag

**Lining:** Length = 2x length of laptop/iPad + 9 inches for closing flap x

Width = 1x laptop/iPad + 2 inches

(for my laptop for measures  $13\frac{1}{4}$  (width)  $\times$   $9\frac{1}{4}$  (length) inches, I started with a piece fabric that measures 27  $\frac{1}{2}$  (width) x 15  $\frac{1}{4}$  (length) inches)

Wadding or Pellon: Same as Lining

(these do not need to be whole piece of fabric/wadding/pellon, it can be stitched together to create the required length)

Outer: Bring along all your scraps and left overs and we will fill the lining with a crazy patch guiltyou-go. You will need enough fabric to cover your lining

Binding: Length = 2x width + 1x length of your piece of lining fabric x 2  $\frac{3}{4}$  inches (so for my laptop I had  $70 \frac{1}{4} \times 2 \frac{3}{4}$  inches for my binding)

Closer: Button, Velcro, hooks, ribbon (pretty much whatever you have on hand) I will help you make it into a closer for your bag.

#### In addition -

Machine: Sewing machine with usual attachments

Make sure you have the normal sewing foot and a walking foot if you have one

Rotary cutter with a new blade

Threads: any normal sewing threads. Grey or cream will blend with everything

Someone called Diane gave her a quilt.


His wife Kathy died a year ago and he is keen to say thank you to Diane for the quilt."


