CYCLONE TRACY 40 YEAR ANNIVERSARY QUILT CHALLENGE

On Christmas Eve 1974, Darwin was destroyed by Cyclone Tracy.

The effect on people who lived through the cyclone was, and still is profound.

We invite you, the Quilters of Australia to make a quilt that reflects your depiction/memories of that time and Cyclone Tracy. You need not have lived in Darwin at the time, or experienced the cyclone, but remember it through different media/personal stories.

First Prize: \$250.00

Second Prize: \$150.00

Third Prize: \$100.00

Viewer's Choice Prize: \$200.00

The quilt size is A4 (29.5 \times 21 cm) and in portrait profile. The quilt must comprise of three layers and must be quilted. Any technique or combinations of techniques can be used to make the quilt. The finished quilt must have hanging sleeves on the top and bottom of the back of the quilt.

The quilts will become the property of Darwin Patchworkers & Quilters Inc. who will join the quilts together to create a community art piece.

Tutor: Pam Pemberton

Requirements List:

Materials

Fat quarter of fabric of choice – print, batik or solid

Fat quarter of lining fabric – white or light tone on tone

16" square (41cm square) of light weight batting – Pellon is okay

4 x sets press studs - 12 or 13mm

6" (15cm) 6mm of elastic

Complimentary button

Scraps of wool batting, wool fleece or wool flannel for pincushion stuffing.

Co-ordinating or contrasting thread.

Tools

Sewing machine and accessories – your 'walking foot' may be useful

Sharp fabric scissors

Pins

Hand needles (for sewing press studs and button)

Washable marking pen

Tape measure

Small quilting ruler (eg. 6" square), if you have one

Chopstick or knitting needle (for defining corners)
