

2 contrasting fabrics (Christmas) 12" x 7"

Matching thread

Vlisofix 12" x 7"

Narrow ribbon approx 11"

1 small bell

24 small gold beads

small piece of template plastic

Building on the great success of our past community activities, we at Quilt around the World have started a new global patchwork project: the 3<sup>rd</sup> International Block Swap. This time, the motto is "In the Sun." Today, we would like to invite you

and all your quilt-loving guild members to join in and become part of an exciting multinational and cross-cultural patchwork

activity!

#### "In the Sun"

The sun is the brightest central celestial body of our universe and the most important star for humanity. Life on our planet is only possible because the sun sends its warming heat and light rays down to us on the earth...

What do you personally associate with the sun? Tell us with your patchwork motif! Quilters around the world, no matter whether novice, occasional quilter or professional, are invited to design 9 patchwork blocks on the motto "In the Sun" and send them to us. All participants then will be grouped into international teams, within which the 9 blocks will be exchanged by our team. So, you will receive a surprise package with the makings of a unique sunshine guilt containing 9 different blocks along with personal greetings from quilters around the world.

The deadline for the finished blocks is May 31, 2016. You can find all details in the IBS3 download flyer http://www.quiltaround-the-world.com/sites/default/files/images/story/4509/ibs3-flyer\_en.pdf or on our website at http://www.quilt-around-theworld.com/en/content/3rd-international-block-swap.

The participation fee for each set of blocks is 25 Euros to cover the postage and packaging for the return of the individual block packages to our participants worldwide and some of the follow-up activities like international exhibitions, catalogue etc.

For each IBS3 block package we will also donate at least 1 Euro to Doctors without Borders to support their medical work in all countries where the survival of people is endangered by conflicts, epidemics or natural disasters.

Would you be so kind as to pass the IBS3 information on to your guild members and/or to mention the project on your homepage and your guild magazine? Please let us know if you'd like us to provide you with additional information and graphical material for your publication.
