
Barb invented a new method of quilting, involving having as many electronic devices as possible running at the same time

Bernadette's apple cake recipe (by request from the "ladies of the night")

German Apple Cake.

300 gms Butter 270 gms Raw Sugar 3 large Eggs 3 Cups SR flour 100 gms sultanas 3 x 375gm tins Sliced Apples.

Teaspoon Cinnamon

3 tibl spoons Raw Sugar .

Juice of 1 lemons

Melt butter.

Mix in Raw Sugar. Do not stir for too long because you do not want the sugar to dissolve too much.

Beat in Eggs and flour.

Spread 1/3 of the mixture on bottom of pan and flatten out to the edges of the baking tray. Spread 15 1/2 x cans of apples over base

Sprinkle sultanas over apples.

Combine Cinnamon and Raw Sugar and sprinkle over sultanas and apples.

Spread 21 & 1/2 x cans of apples over sultans.

Pour lemon juice over apples.

Spread remaining mixture over the apples. This can be done by breaking small amounts of mixture off and placing over the apples to give a rough texture.

Bake in Moderate oven (180) degrees for approx 1 - 1/2 hours or until golden brown.

I usually make this in a medium size foil BBQ tray which can be purchased from your local supermarket.
