Saturday Stitchers for February 2017

12:00 noon to 4:00pm Raw Edge Applique 1.01

We will be exploring raw edge appliqué from the beginning with how to use patterns, Vliesofix, stabilizers, different threads and stitches. The GO die cutter will be demonstrated and used during the session. This will assist those new to appliqué and those who want to contribute with their already acquired skills.



Requirements:

- Sewing machine with a new needle (bring your machine manual if you can)
- Open toed foot
- Scraps of materials (include one with a medium sized motif)
- Half a metre of plain background material (this could also be a scrap)
- A variety of threads
- 0.3 m of Vliesofix (at least)
- a pencil
- small, sharp scissors and paper scissors
- Teflon mat if you have one

Bring along any projects or patterns you would like to share or need assistance with.

Saturday Stitchers is always open to those who do not want to participate in the lesson but would like to share in the fellowship of the day.
