Woven Fabric Baskets With Heather Van Muster

Instructions at terryatkinson.typepad.com

Materials needed

- 1) 20 strips 2.5" x 21"
- 2) 40 strips 0.5" x 20" Décor bond fusible interfacing
- 3) 20 strips 0.5" x 20"
- 4) Fabric Glue
- 5) Wonder clips or other clips to hold top of basket (could use what you use for holding binding) or pegs
- 6) Scissors

Note I used a mixture of visoflex, steam a seam or something similar, essentially it needs to have glue on both sides. I am going to use up the steam a seam I purchased from Pam Holland as the basket doesn't need sewing and it will use up what I have.
