Fabric Bowl

From Linda Johansen: Fast Fun and Easy Fabric Bowls - Available through DP&Q library



You will need:

- 2 fat quarters of complementary fabrics
- optional 5" scraps for bases
- 0.4 m double sided Peltex (45cm wide available from Dragonfly Fabrics)*see note
- a piece of vliesofix 10" x 5"
- 2 reels of thread either to match or contrast
- $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square quilter's ruler
- pencil or fabric marking pen
- rotary cutter and mat
- scissors
- sewing machine that will do satin stitch

Note: You can use stiff bag wadding but you need extra vliesofix

You can adjust sizes and shapes but the techniques are the same if you want to make more than one on the day.
