On Sunday 19th January, a group of ladies lead by Annie R got together to start making our next raffle quilt, and it is looking magnificent.



21 MARCH 2020 | TIME: 10AM TO 3PM

BLOCK KEEPER

(Designed by Leanne Beasley and featured in Australian Homespun Bag Boutique ©2010)

Requirements List:

- 0.5 metre feature fabric (cover)
- 1 metre coordinating fabric (lining)
- 1 metre x 240 cm wide cotton or bamboo batting
- 2 x 40.5 cm (16 inch) square pieces of foam core board*
- For fastening:
 - o a) 2.3 metres of 11mm (½ inch) ribbon in coordinating colour OR
 - o b) 60 cms of 6mm (1/4 inch) elastic and 3 x 30mm buttons

(*NB Foam core board is available at Jacksons Art Supplies, Parap; & at Office Works, Stuart Park)

Cutting:

NB: It is essential that you come to the workshop with your materials already precut.

- From the feature fabric
 - cut one rectangle 17" x 35" (cover)
- From the lining fabric
 - cut one rectangle 17" x 35" (lining) and
 - two rectangles 17" x 17.5" (insert linings)
- From the batting
 - o cut one rectangle 17" x 35" (support) and
 - three rectangles 15.5" x 31" (dividers)
- From the ribbon
 - cut 6 x 15" strips OR
 - o from the elastic cut 3 x 20mm (8") pieces

General Supplies:

- Sewing machine and 1/4 inch foot
- Pencil and water-erasable fabric marking pen
- Rotary cutter and 24 inch ruler
- Sewing machine thread
- General sewing supplies
- Your lunch.


VISITORS WELCOME
