RECIPE OF THE MONTH

RUSTIC SEAFOOD PATTIES 11/2 cups breadcrumbs



500G Marinara mix chopped 2 tbs Whole Egg Mayonnaise (plus extra to serve) 2 spring onions sliced 2tbs chopped fresh parsley 1 tbs capers, rinsed, chopped 1 lemon, rind finely grated, cut into wedges 1 egg lightly whisked vegetable oil to shallow fry areen salad to serve

Combine Marinara mix. breadcrumbs. mayonnaise, spring onion, parsley, capers, lemon rind and eggin a bowl. Shape into small patties. Place on a baking tray lined with baking paper. chill for 30 minutes.

Heat oil in a pan over medium heat. Cook patties in batches for 4-5 minutes each side until golden. Serve with green salad, extra mayonnaise and lemon wedges.
