BIRDS NEST BOWLS

REQUIREMENTS : -

Threads - leftovers, unwanted or old reels of cotton, embroidery, metallic variegated, fine lace - anything goes really

Organza – 2 pieces approx 12½" x 12½" per bowl

Solvy - 60 cms should be enough for two bowls

Embroidery hoop - 8" or 10" is a good size

Small bowl - glass or polystyrene ball to shape your bowl

General Supplies: Sewing machine with a free motion foot

Sewing machine thread for stitching over the solvy - poly, rayon, variegated

A least 2 filled bobbins to match top thread

General sewing supplies

Your lunch.

2 eggs 1 tsp vanilla 1 cup / tub yoghurt (any type will so) 1 ¹/₂ cups SR Flour + 1 tsp Baking Powder
