Time: 10am to 2pm

BIRDS NEST BOWLS

REQUIREMENTS : -

Threads - leftovers, unwanted or old reels of cotton, embroidery, metallic variegated, fine lace - anything goes really

Organza - 2 pieces approx 12½" x 12½" per bowl

Solvay - 60 cms should be enough for two bowls

Embroidery hoop - 8" or 10" is a good size

Small bowl - glass or polystyrene ball to shape your bowl

General Supplies:

Sewing machine with a free motion foot

Sewing machine thread for stitching over the solvy - poly, rayon, variegated

A least 2 filled bobbins to match top thread

General sewing supplies

Your lunch.

Breaking news....2020 Workshops!

Kathy Doughty from Material Obsession Sydney NSW, has been in touch with DPAQ and is still available to tutor a two day workshop from Saturday 15th August 2020. There are still several places available if you would like to attend.

Her workshop will focus on providing tips and ideas that encourage each participant to take control of the decision processes of patchwork. Participants learn how to read fabric, create interesting combinations and to achieve a unique look that reflects their own personal taste.

The quilt Over Grown (below), from her new book Organic Applique will be the focus of this workshop. This project is designed to exercise choosing fabrics for the pieced sections, and experimenting with freeform applique in the borders.

Charity Quilts

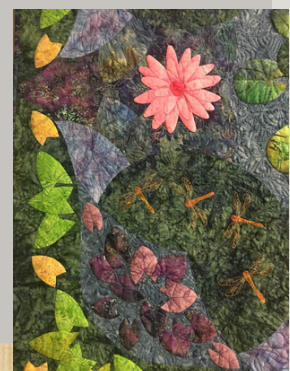
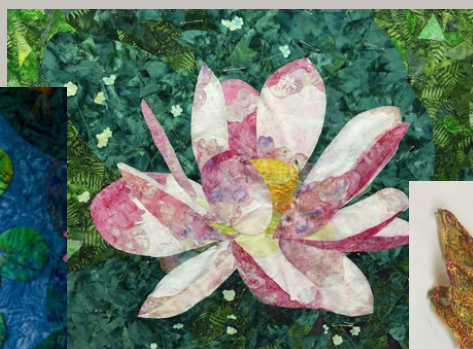
What a great effort DPAQ members have done over the years making quilts for charity. It's great that so many members are committed to helping in the community by making and donating quilts of all sizes and colours.

Add 2 eggs
 1 tsp vanilla
 1 cup / tub yoghurt (any type will so)
 1 ½ cups SR Flour + 1 tsp Baking Powder

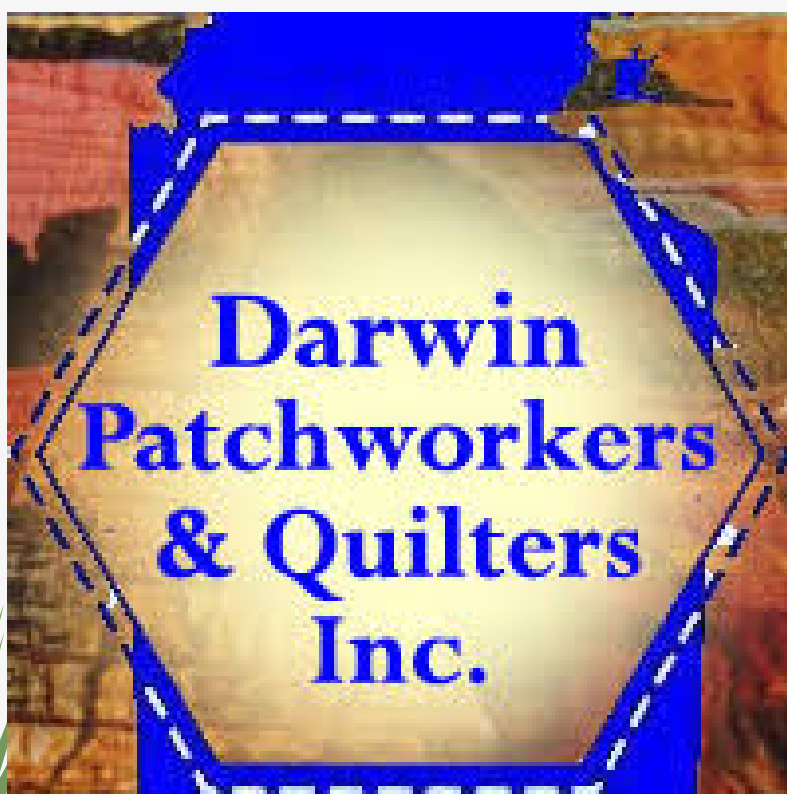

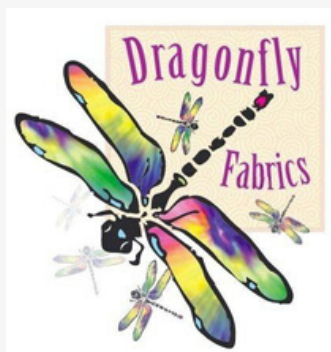
