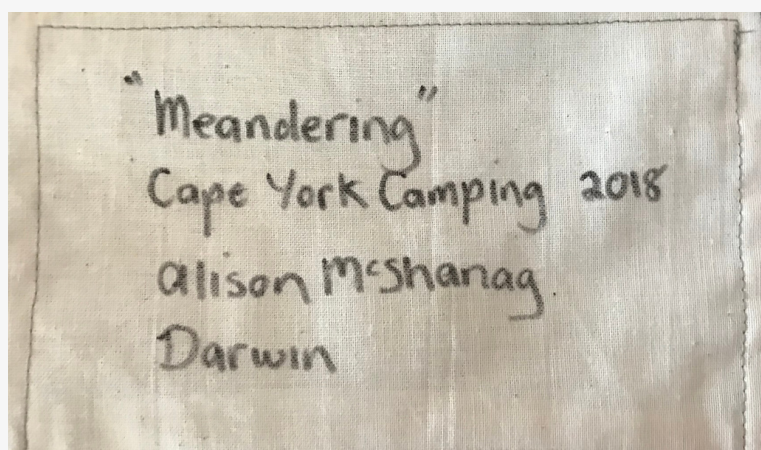

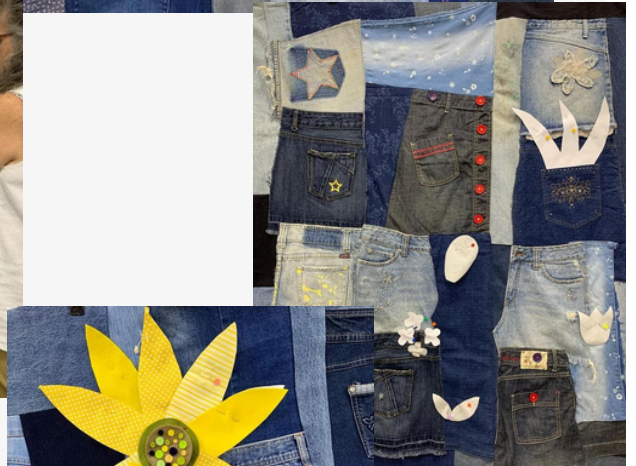

ZOOM presentation – My Top 10 Art quilt Techniques

Description

With a slide show and Q&A discussion, grab a cuppa tea as I share my favourite techniques that I use to create my art quilts. I discuss painting with acrylic on fabric, my easy ways to painting with dye & salt, and my “secret squirrel” technique of painting with bleach. I share free-motion yarn couching techniques and how I physically manage my current passion to quilt BIG! I probably share too much including my shoe size!

We enjoy a chat for 45minutes – 1hour with Q & A.

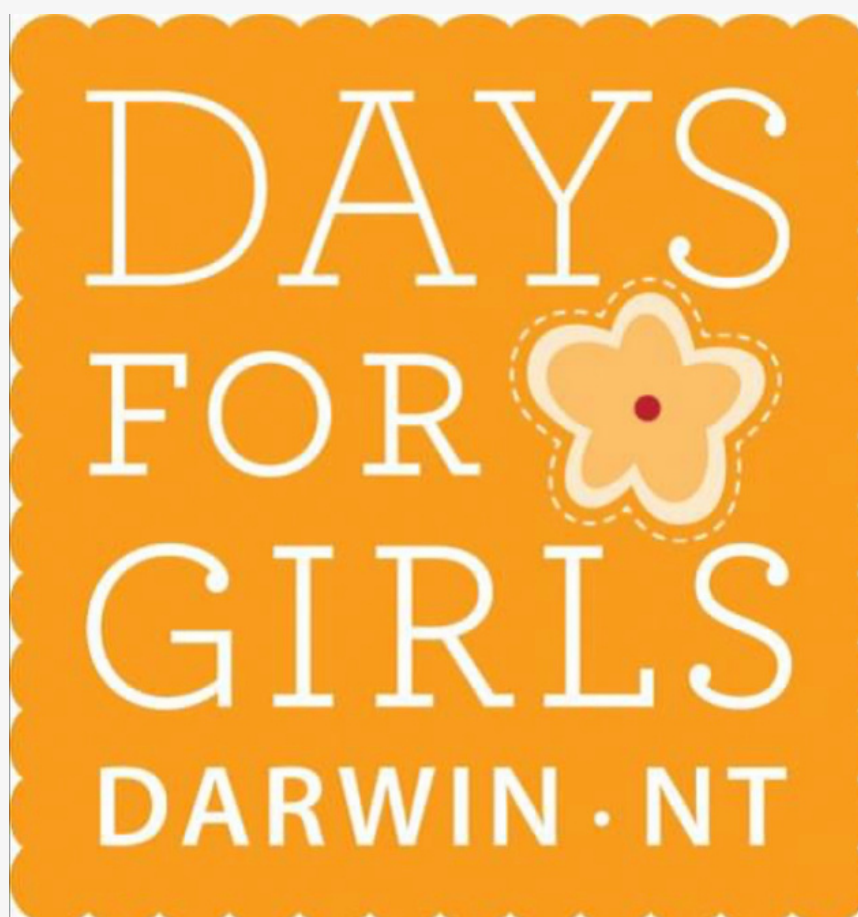

Rhubarb and Ginger cake recipe

Serves 8 - 10

180g of butter at room temperature

1cup of brown sugar firmly packed

3 eggs

2 tsp ground cinnamon

1 1/2 cups self raising flour

1/2 cup plain flour

33g sour cream

1 bunch rhubarb, trimmed, cut into 2cm pieces (approx 3 cups)

125g bag of gláze ginger roughly chopped

1 tbsp icing sugar to serve

thick cream to serve

FOR THE TOPPING

1/3 cup self raising flour

40g butter cubed and chilled

1 tbsp brown sugar

2 tbsp toasted hazelnuts, roughly chopped

Preheat oven to 180c. Grease and line a 22cm round loose baked cake pan with baking paper.using an electric beater, beat butter and sugar until light and creamy. Add eggs one at a time beating well after each addition. Sift the cinnamon and half the self raising flour and plain flour over the cake mixture. Add half the sour cream..Sift remaining flour over cake mixture and add remaining sour cream. Gently stir u til combined. Fold through rhubarb and half the gláze ginger. Spoon into prepared cake pan.Smooth the top with the back of a wet spoon. Place topping flour in a bowl. Using your fingers rub butter into the flour. Stir through sugar, hazelnuts and remaining ginger. Sprinkle mixture over the top of the cake. Bake for 1 hour to 1.5hojrs or u til cooked through when tested with a skewer . Stand for 10 minutes before removing from the pan. Serve dusted with icing sugar and thick cream on the side.

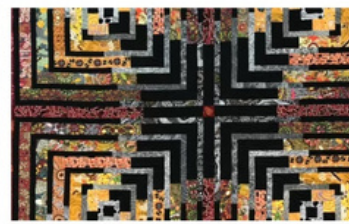
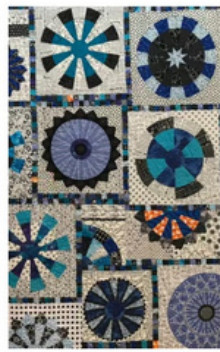
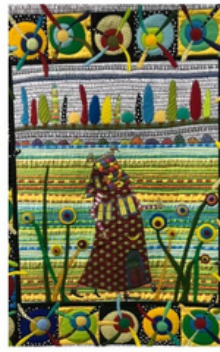

To book your machine in for servicing you *MUST email & answer the 4 Questions* . We will then book your machine in and advise you by return email of the day to bring your machine in. As usual it will be on a first in first serve basis.

If there is anything else that you need please ask us.

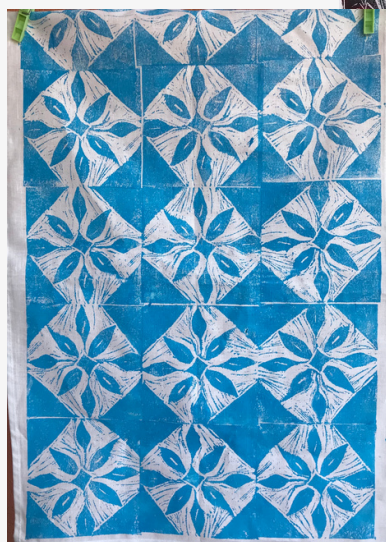

Fabric and paper Lino printing with "Landshapes Art" at Tactile arts studios.

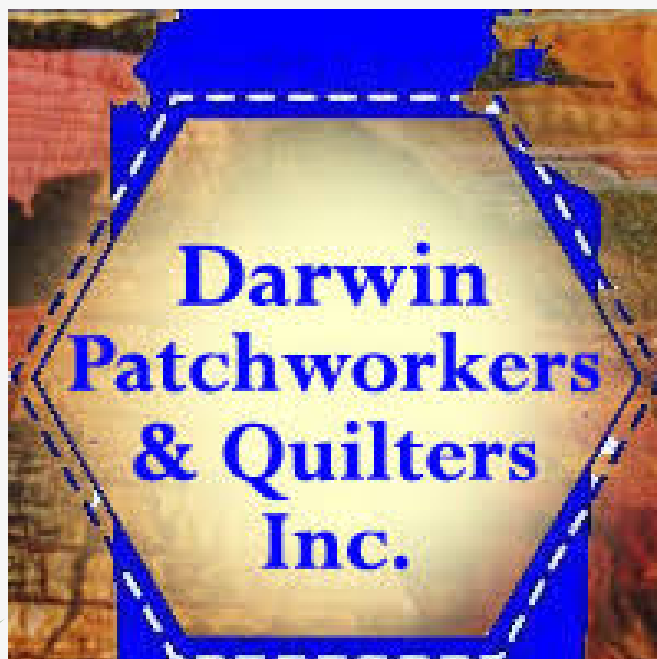

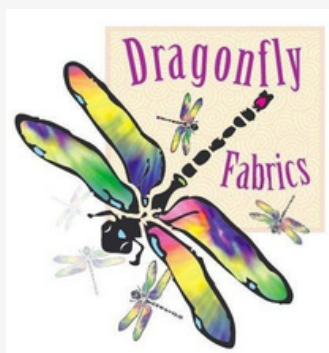
