Saturday Stitches March Needle Turn Appliqué with Joy Baker

19th March 2022: 10am

This will be a technique class so fabric requirements are small -

- 1 fat quarter of fabric for background
- Small selection of scrap fabrics (eg minium 6 inch squares)
 for test pieces. Choose cotton fabric with a close weave but
 NOT Poplin
- Hand sewing needles
- Thread
- Small sharp scissors for fabric
- Paper scissors
- Pencil -and wash out markers can be used for quick projects.
 Chalk pencils
- best work will be achieved using finer appliqué needles and thinner thread eg thread 60/2 or Bottom Line. I will have a small selection of these items for people to try on the day.

Class will cover

- Marking pens/pencils
- Preparation of background blocks
- Threads
- Fabric

Techniques demonstrated

- Inner points
- Curves
- Leaf points
- Circles
- Bias stems



Free motion embroidery stitched through interesting layers of gorgeous hand-dyed fabrics to create wonderful textures and depth.

Learning to build up a base fabric, fusing layers of fabrics and fibres. The second and third layers of the artwork may involve cutting, tearing, stitching, cutting through all the layers to create a lacework section, using water-soluble fabrics, fusing silk fibres, 3-dimensional embellishment, hand stitching, framing and finishing your artwork.




Library News






