
Quilt Appraisal Dates for 2019

24 November

Quilting tip from Jacquie Gering's book Walk

To avoid having numerous threads to bury in your quilt when you have finished quilting, try this method instead. This is for when you are using a walking foot for straight or slightly curved lines. You need a machine that will remember your last stitch settings for this to work. First try out stitch lengths and tension on the very edge of your quilt border – the part that will be hidden under the binding. Program that stitch length. Where the quilting line has to start, drop the needle down once while holding the top thread firmly. Bring the needle up again, gently pull the top thread, and the loop of the bobbin thread will appear. Use a satay stick or similar to lift the loop in the bobbin thread until the end appears.





Hold both threads to the left side of the foot. Switch to zig-zag stitch and set the stitch width to zero and the stitch length very short – I tried 0.3, but 0.4 suits me better. Slowly take 5 or 6 stitches and stop. Now switch back to your straight stitch setting and continue your line of quilting. When you get to the end of the line stop one stitch short of the end and switch back to zig zag. Do about 6 stitches. You can now lift the presser foot, pull you r work to the side and snip the two threads close to the work and they will not unravel. If you accidentally quilted right up to the end of the stopping point, when you switch to zig zag you can reverse over the last stitch to fasten off.

Fabric Mat with Christine Garrett

This project can be constructed using scraps of both wadding and fabric.

Requirements:

- 2½" strips of fabric joined end to end (approx 20 23 metres of half a jelly roll)
- 2½" strips of wadding joined end to end (approx 20 metres)
- sewing machine in good working order
- jeans needle greater than size 12
- thread to contrast or match
- extension table for your machine will help keep your project flat
- general sewing supplies
