Vliesofix


Reef - 5 blue fabrics 5" x half width of fabric, fabric scraps for seaweed. The fish, turtle and dolphin and rocks are fussy cut from fabrics. Vliesofix.

Sewing machine, general sewing supplies.

Rotary cutter with sharp blade.

New Additions for the library :=



A New Twist on STRIPS 'N CURVES by Louisa L Smith

**Please add a label on the back**


## **Volunteers for TQ21**




