

# Jemima Flendt Trunk Show


Tied with a Ribbon

## Pop-Up Workshop - Double Project Bag



### Requirements:

Main fabric	0.70 m
Lining fabric	0.75 m
Co-ordinating fabric	0.60 m
Bag foam	22" x 15"
Plastic for small pockets	12" x 14"
Plastic for large pocket	15" x 7"
Iron-on interfacing	0.30 m
Zips	3 x 12" and 1 x 15"
Velcro	2"
Buttons	2 x 15mm or 20mm

### IMPORTANT


To everyone doing this class, it would be helpful if you could have your main fabric piece, bag foam and lining fabric quilted before class. The size should be 22" x 15". It would save a lot of time and you can quilt it as much or as little as you like.




**Quilted Jackets** - for those of you who have exhausted the quilt thing, maybe move onto quilting a jacket for yourself or someone you love.
